Component Details

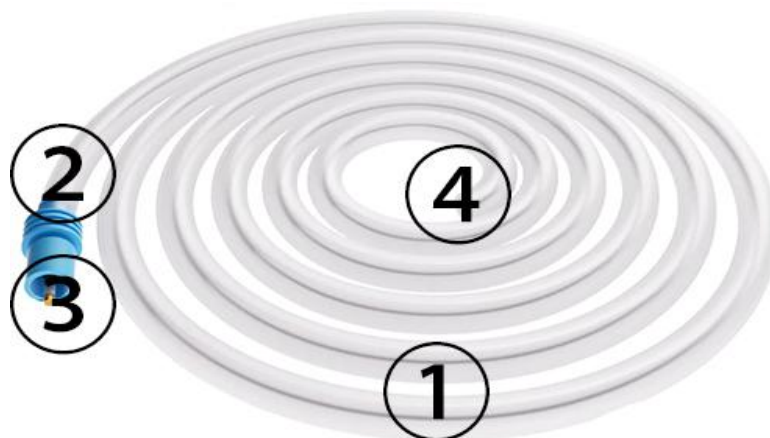
1. Urine Collection Cup



①Handle

②Hole for the metal urine sensor probe

2. Drainage Tube



①Drainage tube

②Quick connector

③Metal urine sensor probe

④Urine sensor wire

3. The Host and User Interface



- ①Type-C USB interface
- ②Groove (to open the lid)
- ③Power switch ON/OFF
- ④Manual working/cleaning switch START
- ⑤Display screen(to show used times, remained battery power and low-battery signal)

4. Urine Collection Bottle



①Handle

②Urine collection bottle

Note: When covering the lid of the bottle, please rotate the lid until the lid is covered tightly if you find the lid is not close to the edge of the bottle. (Airflow generates in the bottle when the lid is pressed into the inside of the bottle, which triggers the lid is a little bit difficult to cover)

Operation Guide

Step 1. Wash and dry the urine collection cup with room-temperature water.

Step 2. Insert the metal sensor probe into the groove at the bottom of the urine collection cup. It should be nice and tight to avoid leaking.

Step 3. Put the handheld urine collection cup between the legs.

Step 4. Press and hold ON/OFF for 2-3 seconds to turn the device on.

Step 5. When the urine sensor probe detects urine liquid, the pump will start sucking urine away after just 0.5 seconds. The device continues pumping for six seconds to ensure nothing is left in the tube even if there is no urine collected in the urine collection cup.

Note:

- The end of the drainage tube connected with the lid is undetachable in actual device.
- The device only automatically works when the urine sensor probe detects the urine once the device is turned on.

Cleaning Guide

1. Daily Clean

1.1 Clean the Urine Collection Cup

Step 1. Removing the urine collection cup from the underwear, rinsing it in running water until the urine stains on the inner wall is none.

Step 2. Brushing the inside and outside of the urine collection cup with a soft-bristled brush. Keep rinsing when brushing.

Step 3. After rinsing and brushing, dry the cup by air or clean tissue.

Warm Tips

- The cup is better to be cleaned once everyday.
- Some folding areas are easy to hide, like stains, try to brush these areas cautiously.
- When brushing, it is better to brush the cup along with its shape.

1.2 Clean the Drainage Tube

Step 1. Preparing a small bucket filled with clean water. Ensuring the lid of the urine collection cup is tight.

Step 2. Putting the metal sensor probe in the clean water. And then press and hold the START button, the probe will absorb the clean water through the tube and eventually into the urine collection bottle.

Step 3. The exterior of the tube can be washed directly in running water. After the tube is clean, wipe the outside of the tube with a towel or issue.

Warm Tips

- The tube is better to be cleaned once every two days so as to avoid later stubborn stains.
- Please note that the tube's tip connecting with the lid is non-detachable.
- Please try not to strongly fold or bend the tube so as to avoid the inner wire being broken.

1.3 Clean the Urine Collection Bottle

Step 1. Filling the bottle with appropriate water with an amount of detergent, waiting for 5 minutes.

Step 2. With a rubber glove and a long-handle brush, brush the inside of the bottle to get rid of urine stains. Remember to check the inside of the handle for hidden stains.

Step 3. Rinse the bottle inside and out, then leave to air dry in a ventilated area.

Warm Tips

- We recommend rinsing it every day and washing it every three days.
- You don't need to rinse the lid of the bottle, just wipe it with a tissue and alcohol.
- Please keep water away from the power interface stored inside the lid.
- Please keep water away from where the drainage tube connects to the bottle.
- The inner closing to the handle is easy to hide stains, please pay more attention to the area when brushing.

2. Deep Clean

Disinfecting the Probe

We recommend disinfecting the metal probe once a week by using light salt water or 75% alcohol for five minutes. On the days in between, use alcohol tissues to wipe it down.

Disinfecting the Drainage Tube

Fill a container with light salt water and put the probe into the water, then press START. The device will pump the salt water through the pipe to clean it.

Disinfecting the Urine Collection Cup

Deeply clean 1-2 times a week. Fill the urine collection bottle with light salt water and leave it to soak for 10 minutes before scrubbing inside with a brush – then leave it to dry.

Warm Tips

There is a risk of damaging the probe if the density of salt water is too high. Therefore, the amount of salt should be appropriate as per the amount of water you prepare.

Attention Tips

About using

1. Please read the instructions before use.
2. Proceed with caution if you are allergic to silicone.
3. Stop using the urination device immediately if you have an allergic reaction.
4. We recommend practicing with the device before first use.
5. Please keep the urine collection bottle flat and secure to avoid leaking.
6. Users with dementia should use with caution or under the care of caregivers.
7. Please check the health and hygiene of private parts before use. Monitor for any negative reactions to the materials / product.
8. Try not to bend or block the drainage tube.
9. Stop using the device immediately if you notice redness or swelling.
10. Please do not share the device among multiple users for hygiene and safety reasons.
11. Please follow the posture advice in the user manual while wearing the device.
12. Even when the device is not in use, it should be charged once every 30 days to keep the battery healthy.
13. Do not store the urine collection bottle in conditions below 0 degrees Celsius when liquid is inside.
14. This device is only suitable for use as advertised – no other use cases.
15. When the device needs to be discarded, please follow local laws as per battery disposal.
16. Keep an eye on the skin around the crotch area every four hours and stop if there are signs of any discomfort.

17. Clean the skin around the crotch once every 12 hours to promote health and hygiene.

18. A green lightning icon will glow when the battery is below 10% and the device needs charging.

About cleaning

1. Please follow our cleaning guidelines to reduce the risk of odor, bacteria, and general poor hygiene.

2. Please keep water away from the USB power interface in the lid of the bottle.

3. Please do not use salt water or disinfectant with high density on the metal sensor probe.

4. If the user has diabetes, the device should be cleaned even more regularly because diabetic urine can corrode the metal sensor probe at a faster rate.
